And it is Likewise ffurther Ordered that the said James Neale shall also pay and Allow unto the said John Balley his Costs and Damages by him susteined by reason of the p<sup>r</sup>misses. To be Cast up Accounted and Allowed of by his Excellency Charles Calvert Esq<sup>3</sup> the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Phillip Calvert Esq<sup>3</sup> Chancell<sup>r</sup> and the Hon<sup>ble</sup> William Calvert Esq<sup>3</sup> or any two of them. And what they or any Two of them shall so cast up Compute and Allow to be paid by the said James Neale to the said John Balley for his Costs and Damages afforesaid It is hereby ffurther Ordered and Decreed that the same shall stand Rattified and Confirmed by the Decree of this Court to all intents & purposes without any Appeals from the same or Repeale thereof And the same is to be paid by the said James neale unto the said John Balley Accordingly. And in pursuance of the last Recited order his Excelly Charles Calvert Esq<sup>3</sup> the Hon.<sup>ble</sup> Phillip Calvert & Willm Calvert Esq<sup>3</sup> did in the p<sup>r</sup>sence of the Complt Balley and his Attorney (none Attending for the defend<sup>t</sup> neale though due notice was given to his Attorney) peruse and Examine a Noate of the perticuler Costs and Damages pduced to them by the said John Balley. And haueing Seriously veiwed the same and duely Considered thereof Did thinke ffitt and so order. That the said John Balley be Allowed for his Costs and Charges Expended in these causes. The su<sup>m</sup>e of Twelve Thowsand Two hundred Twenty nyne pounds of Tobacco and Casque for Chancell<sup>rs</sup> Secretaryes and sheriffes ffees: And for his Imprisonm<sup>t</sup> and other ffees. And ffurther they did order and Allow to the said John Balley for his Damages and staying here and being out of his Tobaccoes Three yeares The su<sup>m</sup>e of Twenty pounds Sterling p<sup>r</sup> ann. which in all Comes to the sume of Sixtie pounds Sterling which in Tobacco at One penny p<sup>r</sup> pound comes to the sume of ffourteene Thowsand foure hundred pounds of Tobacco. As also the sume of eight pounds sterl. for Eighty hhds of Tobacco being the produce of the said wyne to be paid by the said Neale to the said Balley for the Imposition of Two shillings p<sup>r</sup> hogshd. lately laid upon Tobacco. the one moyetie of the said Eight pounds sterl. to be to the use of the said Balley and the other moyetie to the use of the said nethway which said su<sup>m</sup>e of eight pounds sterl in Tobacco at one penny p<sup>r</sup> pound Comes also to the su<sup>m</sup>e of nynteene hundred & Twenty pounds of Tobacco All which said sev<sup>r</sup>all su<sup>m</sup>es Allowed for Costs and Damages as afforesaid Doe in the whole Amount unto the su<sup>m</sup>e of Twenty Eight Thowsand five hundred & fforty foure pounds of Tobacco, which said su<sup>m</sup>e of Twenty eight Thowsand five hundred & fforty foure pounds of Tobacco Togeather with the su<sup>m</sup>e of Thirty Three Thowsand fforty & Six pounds of Tobaccoe fformerly Decreed to be paid by Neale to Balley, in all, Sixtie One Thowsand ffive hundred and nynetye pounds of Tobacco,
