Read the Petition of Sundry the Inhabitants of Cæcil County and of Lancaster County in Pennsylvania Praying a Bill may be brought in granting them a Priviledge to clear a Road from Elihu Halls Mill down Octorara to the Mouth thereof and so down Susquehanna River along the Bottom to the Top of the hill Rejected
