Knowe all men by these presents that I Edmund Lyndsey of Port-tobaccoe in Charles County planter Hauē Sould and by these p^rsents doe sell for A vallewable Considera^on unto Gyles Glouer of the County aforesaid Planter Two hondred Acres of Land Lyinge and beinge upon th^e Eastermost Branch of Avon Riuē Runinge North and by west for breadth and East and by north for Length into the woods; To haue and to hold the said Land with all Just priuelledges and Profitts unto him th^e said Gyles Glouer his heires and Assignes, from th^e date hereof for Euer, And further I the said Edmond Lyndsey doe warant th^e said sale from all Just Clames in the Law, In testimony whereof I haue hereunto set my hand and seall this 4th septemb^r 1660: 255

Mathew Benham Enters his marke of Cattle and Hoggs (viz) Cropt on th^e right Ear with two slitts in th^e Crope and swallow forked on th^e left Ear [p. 104] 256

James Langworth Enters his marke of Cattle and Hoggs, The Right Ear slit the left Ear Cropt and A peace Cut away on th^e uper syde of the Cropt Ear 257

William Langworth Enters his marke of Cattle and Hoggs (viz) The Right Ear slit and the under part of the slit cut away the left Ear Cropt and A Little peice Cut away on th^e uper syde of the Cropt Ear 258

Mary Langworth Enters her marke for Cattle and Hoggs (viz) The Right Ear slit, the left Ear Cropt and A slit in the Crope, and A little peice cut Away on th^e uper syde of th^e Cropt Ear 259

Ellizabeth Langworth Enters her marke of Cattle & Hoggs (viz) the Right Ear slitt the left Ear Cropt and two slitts in the Crope, and A Little peice Cut Away on th^e uper syde of the Cropt Ear 260

Robert Greene Enters his marke for Cattle and Hoggs (viz) the Right Ear slit and the under part of th^e slit cut away the Left Ear slit and the uper part of th^e slit cut away 261
