 [fol. 41] whatsoeuer, To make their repaire to th^e Clarkes of their respectiue County Courts, at, or before th^e 20th day of August next ensuinge, to make their Subscription to th^e sd Engagem^t or else th^t they puid^e th^m selues, to dep^t this province by the 25th day of March next And doe Declare th^t all psons th^t shall refuse to subscribe th^e Engagem^t wthin th^e time before limi^t and shall be found in any p^t of this province after th^e 25th day of March aforesd, shall be pceeded against as Rebels, and Traitours. giuen under my hand this 23th of July 1658

That all such Fees as ware due to m^r Thō. Hatton, yo^r Depon^t veriwell remembreth th^t hee hath payd m^r Thō: Marsh decedent th^e Depon^t m^r Thō. Hinsons Charge of Fees is 137^{lb} of To^b & Caske & Further saith not.

Joseph Wickes Sworne this 21th of July 1658

Saith That this Deponant was Indebted by Bill & acc^o unto m^r Thomas Hatton about th^e quanty^{tie} of eighty one Pounds of To^b, w^{ch} bill was in th^e Custodye of m^r Thomas Marsh & the fore s^d To^b was demanded, & payd, upon th^e Geⁿall Ac^{os} betwixt th^e sd Marsh
