Saith That beinge At a Court at Sciuerne sometime aboute Fower or Fiue yeares since, yo^r Depon^t heard Thō: Hinson tell Thomas Marsh, th^t hee had an Execⁿ For m^r Hatton against Lumbards Estate, m^r Marsh answered what doe you tell me of That sd Marsh if you haue neglected yo^r office For ought I Know you must pay th^e debt, what tell you me of it sd Marsh to Hinson, why did not you serue yo^r Execution, & these ware the words or the Full sence there of & Further saith not.
