The Plan^t demands satisfacōn For his goods taken away by an uniuist proceedinge of Henry Carline when he was Sheriffe for this County by reason of not Appraisinge the s^d goods accordinge to Law, whereupon they Joyne Issue

The Court upon a longe debate in th Cause haueinge well considerd the p^rmicesse with the testimony, doth therefore order, that the sd Def^t shall pay to th^e Plan^t one hundred & eighty pounds of Toḅ. & Caske wth all Court Charges, Else Execuōn, But the Court Findinge th^t the Plan^t hath eighty two pounds of Toḅ in his owne hands of th^e Def^t, the Court doth order the same to be discounted hereupon in th^e pl^{ts} one hands.

Henry Carline cominge before this Court Contemptuously wth his hatt on his head contrary to sciull respect to Maiestrates & to an order of Court formerly past in th^t behalfe & openly read in th^e p^rsence of th^e Court & to th^e sd Carline who is disobedient there unto not withstandinge the Admonition giuen him by th^e s^d Court to yeald obedience, But th^e s^d Carline refusinge The Court Consideringe the Contempte doth therefore Order th^t th^e s^d Henry Carline shall pay for a fine 300th of Toḅ & Caske to th^e Lord proprietary & Court charges else Execution

Whereas two Attachm^{ts} Issued out against th^e Esstate of Peter Parker, one for m^r Henry Morgan of two thousand pounds of Toḅ & one for m^r Tho: Ringgold of two thousand fye hundred Pounds of Toḅ, & one for william Granger against the Esstate of Rob^t Tyler for one hundred & Fifty pounds of Toḅ The Court Consideringe th^t th^e ptyes beinge called by th^e Sheriff & none to answar to th^e Pl^{ts} plea upon th^e Attachm^{ts} & that noe full prooffe doth yet appeare th^t th^e Def^{ts} are fled out of th^e Prouince, The Court doth therefore order th^t th^e Pl^{ts} make their Appearance th^e next Court, & in case th^e Def^{ts} answar not accordinge to th^e tenure of th^e writts, that a Just proceedinge may Follow upon their Esstates, And th^t th^e Sheriffe bringe in all th^e Acc^o & bills of th^e sd Parkers to th^e next Court
