Know all men by these p^rsents th^t I John Raby of th^e Isle of Kent Planter doe binde my selfe my heires Exec^{rs} & Admin^{rs} to pay or cause to be payd, unto John Salter both of th^e Isle of Kent Plant^r to him his heires Exec^{rs} Admin^{rs} or Assignes in th^e full some of two Thousand Pounds of sound M^rchantable To^b wthout ground leues in Caske the tenth of Nouem^r 1659, & to th^e true pformance hereof I doe binde ouer unto th^e sd Salter his heires & Assignes, all my Cropp of To^b, w^{ch} I shall plant or make this next ensuinge yeare, And one Blacke Cow by name blacke nann markt wth a Cropp on th^e left eare & underkeeld, & ouer Keeld on th^e Right w^{ch} sd Cropp & Cow I fully make & binde ouer unto th^e s^d Salter wth the Cows increase w^{ch} shall not be disposed of, untill th^e said Salter be fully satisfied & Contented th^e aboute sd some of two Thousand Pounds of To^b & Caske as afore sd In witnesse hereof I haue here unto set my hand this 20th of No^v 1658

Couenanted Conditioned & Agreed in and betwixt John Salter of the one pty & John Raby both of th^e Isle of Kent on th^e other pty witnesseth th^t th^e sd John Salter shall finde & allow unto th^e sd John Raby suffitient ground to plant upon for Corne & To^b for this ensuinge yeare as allsoe howsinge for th^e sd Cropp & to plant together for an equall share in proportion, & that th^e sd Salter shall finde & allow unto th^e sd Raby meat drinke & Lodginge from th^e day of th^e date here of untill this time tweluemonth In considera^on where of th^e sd Raby shall helpe to make such Fenceinge as shall be needfull aboute the Plantation called Beuer necke & to beate Corne for bread
