Soe it was her th^e sd Sarah Tailer, & shee came forth & the maid wisht me not to tell her M^r or M^{rs} & John Deere beinge there, said he would not carry her home, but such victualls as he had shee was welcome too And further saith not.

Sarah Tailer on her Oath saith in open Court that shee was about two howres in th^e house of John Deere when Katteren Gamer was there, but neuer there since nor before nor neuer at John Smiths but when he brought her to his House when th^e Conestable Found yo^r Depon^t there, & further saith not.
