John Dabb demandeth war^t versus Cap^t Rob^t Vaughan in an Actⁿ of debt to th^e vallue of 300^{lb} of Toḅ. & Caske for this he bringeth his suyte. war^t Issued.

Seth Foster demandeth war^t versus Eḏd Coppage in an Action of Debt to th^e vallue of 100^{lb} of Toḅ & Caske for this he bringeth his suyte war^t Issued

William Bagar demandeth war^t versus Daid Maine in an Actⁿ of Battery, for this he bringeth his suyte war^t Issued, 1 subp:

Martin Euens demandeth war^t versus William Bager in an Actⁿ of Assault And battery for this he bringeth his suyte war^t Issued

The Court doth order the Deff^t to pay Coste of suyte Else Execⁿ.
