You shall sware that as Commision^r in the County of Kent in all Artickells in his Lordships Commisiⁿ to you derecked you shall doe equall Right to the poore as to the Rich to the best of your Cunninge witte & poure and after the precedents & Customs of thes prouince & acts of Asimbly thearof made and that ye Holde your sesions or Courts as youe are dericked in your Commision or Acording to Actes of Asimbly prouided in that behalfe and all fines and Amersments
