Wee Jurymen find that th^{re} is Dew to Jn^o Darby One hundred & tenn pounds of Tobb: p me Cornelius Co^megys foreman

Upon th^e vardict of th^s Jury this Court doth Order th^e dft to pay unto th^e p^lt One hundred & tenn pounds of Tobb; with Costs of sute. Else Execu^on;

It is Ordered by th^s Court th^t M^r Cornelius Co^megys be overseer for th^e highwayes of Langford Bay hundred, & th^t he make & Clcar a road from Richard Joanes his house to swan Creeke road According to Act of Assembly w^{ch} roade is to be tenn foot wide, & th^t sufficient bridges be made, in th^e s^d Roade passable for horse & foot if need require.

It is Ordered by th^s Court th^t th^e old roads th^t weare repaired th^e last yeare be all Cleared & made Good, from m^r Joseph Wicks house, to swan Creek road, & th^t sufficient bridges be made in th^e s^d roade passable for horse & foot if need require.

Christopher Andrews & Robert Griffin ouer seers for th^e high wayes of Chester hundred.

It is Ordered by th^e Court th^t John Dabb be ouer seer of th^e high wayes for th^e upper hundred of Kent Iland & th^t all roads th^t are in yo^r division be all Cleared & made good & th^t sufficient bridges be made in th^e said roads passable for horse & foot wheare need requires

It is Ordered th^t Issack winchester be Over seer for th^e Lower hundred of Kent Iland & th^t th^e old Roade from kent point so farre as yo^r hundred goe, be all Cleared & made Good & th^t sufficient bridges be made passable for horse & foot if need require.

It is Ordered by th^s Court th^t Jn^o Dabb shall receiue out of th^e Amercem^{ts} Three hundred & twenty pounds of Tobb, it being th^e Charge of th^e Comission^{ts}
