 thousand plantes & housinge to Cure it in And to haue the priuillidge
 to abide in the planta^on from th^e date heareof untill the next
 Croke after this is fully fnsht which will bee in the yeare of o^r
 lord 1656 only that I the sd william Leedes am to help build soe much
 housinge as shall bee wantinge for to Cure my Croke in, the sayd
 John Erickson to bee at the Charge of workmen & nailes & Car-
 penters diet; & then the sd Erickson is to Enioy & possesse the same
 his heires or Assignes foreuer & for the true p^rformance heareof I
 haue heare unto set my hand this tenth Day of Septemb^r 1655
