To the Worshipth Comisscoⁿs for Talbott County the humble Petti^cõn of Wm: Ladds

Sheweth that yo^r Petticoⁿ being from Whom about his Accasions ther Came Francis Finch to yo^r Petticoⁿ house for Corne which in yo^r Petticoⁿs Loft and yo^r Petticoⁿs wife desiered the said Finch to take his Corne all away Whereupon the said Finch tooke her by the throte And gaue her many abusses in words Soe the Said Finch went his way but Presently Come Againe to yo^r Petticoⁿs wife & She bad the Said Finch goe his way about his Bussnes but Affter Sum^m Words the Said finch took a sticke Stick and strok her on the head Soe that She fell downe to the Ground much hurtt: Soe that yo^r Petticoⁿ is much damaged to the Vallue of two thousand Pounds of tobaccoe

The Primisses Considered yo^r Pett^f Craues that this Worshth Courtt wilbe Pleased to Order that the said Finch may Pay yo^r Petticoⁿ his Damages & to take Such Course that yo^r petticoⁿs wife May be abused noe More And yo^r Petticoⁿ Shall Euer Pray

The Courtt findeth by the Oaths of Wm: Daus & Jn^o Trew that Wm: Ladds his wife gaue the first asalt & Affter Swore that She would Kill him Therefore the Courtt hath Ordred that Wm: Ladds his wife be bound to her good behaiour & that the sheriffe take her into Custody untill she enter into bond with sufficient Securitytie according to th^e aboue said Order: &^c:

Sheweth that In August Last yo^r Petticoⁿ did Couenat with M^r Jn^o Edmundson for to Sarue him two years for the Cure of A Sore Legg But Soe it is that the Said M^r Jn^o Edmundson did assigne yo^r Petticoⁿ unto Richard Holland And the Said Holland was to p^forme Jn^o Edmundson Condi^cõn that is to Say Cure yo^r Petticoⁿs Sore Legg: Yo^r Petticoⁿ hath Sarued ten Months and upwards yett his Legg is Neuer the better Nor Nevere a Cure
