The plaintiffes hauinge made appeare to th^e Cou^{rt} th^t there is
 Just Cause of suspition agst th^e sd W^m Price of his unlawfull killinge
 of hoggs And th^t hee is Alsoe Culpable of th^e breach of an Act of
 Assembly in killinge of a markt hogg Contrarie to th^e sd Act

The Cou^{rt} doth thearefore Order th^t th^e sd W^m Price (beeing
 Conceiued unable to pay a fine exprest in th^t Act affore mentioned)
 for his punnishment shall attend the next Court & shall in Open Cou^{rt}
 stand with a papper upon his breast declaringe his offence, soe longe
 tyme as th^e Court shall appoint, And shall make a publicke acknowledg-
 ment of his fault, And also shall Repaire Cranie bridge soe as to
 lie halfe a foote aboue a Co^mon high watt^r, with a Raille to it, &
 th^e bridge to bee well stak^t & made fast in his place, & this to bee
 p^formd before The next Cou^{rt}

And wheareas th^e said Salter & Price haue liued together, in on
 house & familie, in this tyme of suspition It is furth^r Ordered th^t
 there shall bee a seperation, & th^t th^e sd Price shall forthwith
 remoue & noe longer abide, or Remaine, in house or familie, with th^e
 sd John Salter; & shall pay Cou^{rt} Charges els Execution

Wheareas th^e Cou^{rt} hath Re^c Information th^t W^m Price & Jane
 Salter haue beene much acustomed to take th^e name of God in vaine
 there by transgressinge both th^e lawes of God & man, but in p^ticular
 th^t W^m Price swore three othes & Jane Salter th^e wiffe of Jn^o
 Salter swore twoe Othes heareby transgressing an Act of Assembly
 agst th^t Sinne p^uided; dated Octob^r 20, 54: n^o 11

The Cou^{rt} doth thearefore Order th^t th^e sd W^m Price shall pay
 tenne pounds of to^b for euerie Oath p^ticularized in th^e Information;
 And th^t John Salter shall pay tenne pounds of to^b for ech of those
 Oathes sworn by his wiffe forementioned; the one halfe to publicke
 usses & the other halfe to th^e Informer to bee Collected by th^e
 Sheriffe with Cou^{rt} Charges els Execution
