Caecilius Absolute Lord & Proprietary of th^e Province of Maryland & Avalon Lord Baron of Baltemore &c Knowe Yee That wee reposeing special Confidence & trust in you Stephen Horsey gent haue Constituted ordained & appointed & doe by these p^rsence Constitute ordayne & appoynte you sherriffe of the County off Somerset & to haue such priveledges & benefitts as any other within this o^r province of Maryland now hath or any oth^r sheriffe of yo^r said County ever haue had helld or enioyed or of right ought ought to haue had helld or enioyed To Haue & to Holld th^e said office or Employ^mt for one whole year to be Computed from th^e date hereof & after till anoth^r sherriff by us or our Leutenant or chiefe Govern^r for th^e time being shall be lawfully by pattend Constituted Provided th^t the said Stephen Horsey doe in open Court in his said County take th^e oath of sherriffe hereunto Annexed & giue security for th^e well discharging of his office & trust according to th^e Act of Assembly in th^t Case provided Given att S^t Maryes und^r our Lesser seale of o^r said province the two & twentieth day of August in th^e fue & thirtyth year of our Dominion over th^e said province of Maryland Anno Domini 1666 Wittnes our dear sonne Charles Calvert Esq^r o^r Leuten^t Generall & Chiefe Governo^r of our said province of Maryland
