

Liber B No. 1 thORIZED by th^e right hon^{ble} the Lord p^{roprietary} of this province to passe graunts of Lands und^r th^e greate seale of this p^{vince} to any persons who are desirous to seate themselues in any parte of th^e sea-board side on th^e easterne shore of th^e s^d p^{vince} und^r th^e yearly rent of one shilling sterling for every fiftie acres & th^e usuall Condicons of planta^{con} now helld forth in th^e said p^{vince} & th^t such persons may haue warrants from th^e secretaries office to th^e surveyor generall & his deputies to lay out such p^{porcons} of Land there as shall be agreed to be gra^{nted} to them Given und^r my hand & seale th^e 20th day of July in th^e 35th yeare of his Lordp^s dominion over th^e said p^{vince} A^o D^o 1666

Proclaimed th^e 4th September 1666 in Court

[p. 32] Knowe all men by these presents th^t I Richard Acworth of Manonoakin plantor within th^e province of Maryland hath bought & firmly agreed with Mark Manloue of Pocomoke plantor within th^e same province for a valluable Consideration in hand allready receiued foure Cowes being marked with A Flowerdeluce of th^e right ear & Cropt on th^e left and one black horse of two yeare & a halfe ould being marked with a em m of the right buttock w^{ch} said Cowes with their increase & horse I th^e said Manloue doth sett over & warrant th^e sale of them from me or any under mee unto th^e said Acworth his heires execut^{rs} adm^{rs} or assignes for ever & doth warrant th^e said Acworth A peaceable inioym^t of them from any person or persons that th^t shall lay any claime thereunto as wittnes my hand to the true p^{formance} of this bill of saile I haue hereunto sett my hand this twenty & six day of August 1666 of Marke Wittnes James Davis The marke MM

This Indenture made th^e 10th day of August in th^e yeare of o^r Lord god 1666 Betweene Steven Horse of Anamessick in th^e p^{vince} of Maryland gent: of th^e one parte & Anthony Johnson of Manonoakin in th^e p^{vince} afores^d plantor of th^e other parte Wittnesseth That th^e said Steven Horse for th^e valluable Consideration allready receued hath demised graunted & to farme letten & by these p^{sents} doth demise graunte & to farme lett unto th^e said Anthony Johnson one peece or parcell of Land called Tomes vineyard scituate & being in th^e p^{vince} aforesaid lyeing att th^e south side of wiccocomoco Creeke on th^e easterne shore beginning att a markt oake devideing itt from th^e Land of Wiff Bosman thence running easterly alongst th^e said Creeke one hundred & fifty poles to a markt pine thence running southwest & by west th^e length of three hundred twenty fие poles to a markt tree from thence running westerly th^e bredth of one
