Imprimus That A Tract of Land in th^e most Convenient place for
the whole Countie to be taken up for th^e Counties use & a house
to be builded thereupon

2^{ly} That th^e Com^{rs} according to Act of Assembly & th^e Court being
setting not any one Com^{rs} to depart without leaue of th^e Court
upon penalty of tenne pounds of tobacco for every houre being
absent

3^{ly} That at every Court after th^e Causes are all dispatch upon ad-
iournm^t of th^e Court th^e orders of th^t p^sent Court to be reveiwd
by th^e Commission^{rs} then to be entered according to their
direction

river to Morumsco Dambs neare th^e house of Robert Hignett & from
thence downe to th^e head of Thomas Prices Creeke to th^e head of

Creeke to Watkins pointe From th^e Dambs th^t lyeth by Robert Hig-
netts to th^e Lower Dambs th^t lyeth at th^e head of Anamessicke river
from thence to th^e Lower Dambs th^t lyeth at th^e head of th^e back
Creeke of Manonoakin river And from thence to th^e head of Mano-
noakin river & from thence to the head of Wiccocomoco Creeke

Pocomoke river & th^e eastermost side of Morumsco Creeke to

The bounds of Anamessick Hundred

Anamessicke begininge at Watkins pointe running to the Mouth
of Morumsco Creeke up th^e westermost side of th^e said Creeke to
Morumsco Dambs & from Watkins pointe to the North pointe of
Anamessicke river & from thence runninge up th^e middest of th^t
Nick of Land Called desert

The bounds of Manonoakin Hundred

Manonoakin beginning at th^e North pointe of Anamessicke river
running up th^e Middest of th^e said Nick called desert on th^e North
side And from th^e North pointe of Anamessicke to th^e North pointe
of Manonoakin runninge up th^e Middest of th^t Nick of Land Lyeing
