3^{ly} That at every Court after the Causes are all dispatch upon adiournm^t of the Court the orders of the present Court to be reveiwed by the Commission^{rs} then to be entered according to their direction

From the Landing place upon Capt Goyeders Land in Pocomoke river to Morumsco Dambs neare the house of Robert Hignett & from thence downe to the head of Thomas Prices Creeke to the head of William Colebornes Creeke And from the head of Will Colebornes Creeke to Wattkins pointe From the Dambs the lyeth by Robert Hignetts to the Lower Dambs the lyeth at the head of Anamessicke river from thence to the Lower Dambs the lyeth at the head of the back Creeke of Manonoakin river And from thence to the head of Manonoakin river & from thence to the head of Wiccocomoco Creeke
