No. 2 An Act continuing an Act entitled An Act for the Advancement of Justice.

Be it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That an Act of Assembly of this Province, entitled, An Act for the Advancement of Justice, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis on the second Day of October, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty-three, shall be, and is hereby continued and shall remain and be in full Force, for and during the Term of Three Years, and unto the End of the next Session of Assembly which shall happen after the Expiration of the said Three Years.
