 prietary doth p^rsent that Henry Mitchell Joseph James & John Boul-
 ton of the Clifts Hundred in Caluert County planters the 30th day
 of Nouemb^r in the yeare of Our Lord 1666 at the Clifts Hundred
 in the County aforesaid a certaine hogg of the Goods and Chattles
 of John Tucker plant^r then & there beng found feloniously tooke stole
 killed & carried away ag^t the peace of the Lord Prop^r his rule and
 dignity
