dred Sixty eight Betweene William Bretton of Brettons bay in th^e
County of S^t Mary's in the said Province gen^t and Temperance his
wife of the one part and Henry Waren of S^t Innagoes in th^e s^d
County and Province gen^t of the other part wittnesseth that whereas
th^e said lord Baltimore by his Deed of grant under his greate Seale
used in th^e said Province for granting of lands there bearing date
att S^t Maries th^e Tenth day of July in th^e yeare of our lord one
thousand six hundred & Forty Did for the Considera^{co}ns therein
men^{co}ned grant unto th^e said William by th^e name of William Bret-
ton gen^t All that Necke of land lying in Potomeck ri^u neere o^u ag^t
[p. 687] Herons Island & bounding on th^e South wth th^e said Potomecke ri^u
on th^e west with S^t Clements Bay on th^e East wth a greate bay called
Bretton bay & on th^e North with a line drawne Crosse th^e Woods

called S^t Nicholas Creeke where now goeth th^e hedge of th^e s^d William
