[p. 694] This Indenture made th^e Twelfth day of december in th^e xxxviith yeare of th^e Dominion of Caecilius absolute lord & Proprietary of th^e Provinces of Maryland & Avalon lord Baron of Baltmore &c annoꝝ domini One thousand six hundred sixty eight Betweene Daniell Clarke of th^e County of Talbott in the Province of Maryland planter of th^e One party and Robert Winsmore of th^e Collony of virgā Chirurgeon on th^e other p^{ty} wittnesseth that th^e said Daniell Clarke for & in consideraçon of Foure thousand foure hundred pounds of tobacco to him in hand paid by th^e s^d Robert Winsmore the Receipt whereof th^e s^d Daniel Clarke doth hereby acknowledge & thereof & of eūy p^{te} & p^{cell} thereof Doth hereby acknowledge absolutely & cleerly exonerate acquitt & discharge th^e s^d Robert Winsmore his heires Executo^{rs} Adm^{rs} & assignes by theis p^{nts} hath given granted bargained Aliened sold enfeoffed & confirmed And by theis presents doth give grant bargaine alien enfeoffe & confirme unto him th^e s^d Robert Winsmore his heires & assignes for eū all that parcell of land called Daniels Choice lying on th^e East side of Chesepiake bay in little Choptanke riū in a Creeke called Sharpes Creeke on the North east side of the said Creeke beginning for bredth att a marked pine tree standing by th^e side of the said creeke & running oū th^e creeke south east to a m^ked oke standing in th^e Woods one hund^d & fifty p^{ches} bounded on th^e East with a line drawne North east from th^e said oke for length Three hundred & twenty perches bounded on
[p. 695] th^e North with a line Drawne North west from th^e End of th^e North east line one hundred and fifty p^{ches} bounded on th^e west with a line Drawn South west from th^e for^m line three hundred and twenty perches till itt intersect a pararell from th^e first bounded tree on th^e South with a line Drawne South east over th^e Creeke Conteyning & laid out for three hundred acres more or lesse Together with all
