The def^t Reymond Staplefort for Plea saith, that he and the plaintiffe John Bayley were & are Joynt partners generall of all & all manner of thinges Goods and merchandizes whatsoever, and that these Goods aboue expressed were deliuered to him by the said Bayley to be disposed of in the Joynt partnership betwixt them and of these hee is ready wth all other thinges to come to accompt wth the plaintift and make deuision, there being allowed to each of them respectiely theire disbursm^{ts} and expences wth full allowance of Proffitt and losse as is usuall in all Co-partnership
