This Indenture made the Sixteenth day of December in the xxxviii yeare of the Dominion of Caecilius absolute Lord & Proprietary of the Province of Maryland and Avalon Lord Barron of Baltimore &c Annoq^{ue} Domini One Thousand Six hundred Sixty Nine Betweene George Alderson of Calvert County in the Province of Maryland Tayler on the one P^rte and Alexander Draper of Summeset County on th^e othere P^rty wittneseth that the said George Alderson for & in Considera^on of One Thousand Six hundred pounds of Tobbacco to him in hand paid by the s^d Allexander Draper the Receipt Whereof the s^d Georg Allderson doth hereby Acknowledge, and thereof & of every P^rt & P^rcell thereof doth absolutly and clearly acquitt Exonerate & discharge the said Allexander Draper, his heires Exec^{ts} & Assignes, by these p^rsents hath Given Granted Bargained, Aliened, Sold, Enfeoffed & Confirmed and by these p^rsents doth Give, grant, bargain Sell infeoff and Confirme unto him the said Allexander Draper his heires and Assignes for ever, all that P^rcell of Land Called S^ct Pullcers lying On the East side of Cheseapiake Bay in Transqukein River in the Northwest Branch of the said River on the West side of the Branch begining for the breadth at th^e Eastermost Corner tree of a P^rcell of Land laid out for James Mulakin, & Ruⁿing from th^e s^d tree downe th^e Branch One hundred P^rches south West and by South to a P^rcell of Land laid out for Ishmaell wright and into the Woods for length three hundred & twenty perches north west & by west bounded one th^e North by a line drawne North East & by North one hundred P^rches bounded one the East by a line drawne South East Three hundred and twenty P^rches to the first bounded tree on th^e South with th^e afforesaid Branch Containing & now laid out for two hundred Acres, more or Less Together wth all the Rights & benefitts thereunto belonging as also all Pattents Deeds Writeings &
