A Bill, entituled, An Act to empower the Justices of Somerset and Worcester Counties to levy on the taxable Inhabitants of Coventry Parish, partly in Somerset and Worcester Counties, the Quantity of 62,400 lbs. of Tobacco, for the Uses therein mentioned;

A Bill, entituled, An Act continuing an Act, entituled, An Act for destroying of Crows and Squirrels in particular Counties;

A Bill, entituled, An Act continuing an Act, entituled, An Act, for Repairing the public Roads in this Province, and the Supplementary Act thereto.
