Your Committee have agreed to report the following Amendments (Viz<sup>t</sup>)

That upon a new Inspectors receiving the house from the Old One he shall make two lists of all ~~huds~~ <sup>huds</sup> of Tobacco then in the house which the Old Inspector Shall deliver well nailed, lined & fit for Shipping describing the Marks, Numbers, Gross, Tare, & nett weight Stamped or marked thereon and Sign a receipt at the foot of each List
