That the Justices of Provincial and County Courts shall give in Charge to every Grand Jury, diligently to enquire, and true presentment make, of All Breaches of the Act; and more especially, Whether the Officers Charge any fees Contrary to the true Intention of the Act, and whether the Proprietors of Warehouses keep the Houses, Wharffs, Cranes, Prizes, & other Conveniencies, in good repair, according to the Same.

At the Above meeting, one Justice & one Representative to be appointed, to Cause to be, Surveyed and layed out, one Acre of Land at Emersens Warehouse in Talbot County, for the Use of the Public, none being yet layed but

Inspectors not to deliver Crop Notes or Receipts for Transfer unless they have the Hogsheads actually ready to be delivered for which they deliver such Notes under penalty of five Pounds for every Note or Receipt so delivered.

That there be a penalty of £100, upon each Inspector, in Case of an Inspection house being burnt, where it Can be made appear to be by the Neglect of such Inspector
