M^r Speaker left the Chair, and (with the Other Members of the Lower house) went to the Upper house, and presented to his Excellency, And Ingrossed Bill Ent.^d An Act for the Adjournment of Baltimore County Court; which his Excellency passed into a Law in the usual manner

M^r Speaker (with the rest of the Members) returned to the Lower House and resumed the Chair.

The Order of the day being Read, the house took into consideration the petition of Many Inhabitants near Elk ridge Landing in Ann.^{le} County praying to have a Town erected there and on Motion the Question was put whether it was expedient to erect a Town at Elk ridge Landing or not Resolved in the Affirmative

On Motion Ordered that the petition of many Inhabitants of Elk ridge Landing, be referred for further consideration on the Morrow Morning immediately after the Call of the house

The house Adjourns till the Morrow Morning at 9, of the Clock
