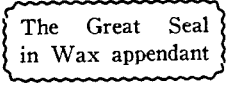

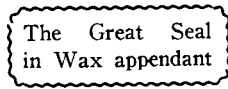
No. 9 An Act Continuing an Act entituled an Act to Prevent Masters
 [No. X] of Ships & Vessels from Clandestinely carrying Servants and
 p. 438 Slaves or Persons indebted out of this Province
 [Passed 21st of November] Whereas an Act of Assembly of this Province made at a Session
 [Preamble] of Assembly began and held at the City of Annapolis on the second
 day of October one thousand Seven hundred and fifty three entituled
 an Act to prevent Masters of Ships and Vessels from Clandestinely
 carrying Servants and Slaves or Persons indebted out of this Province
 hath since by experience appeared to be a Good and Wholesome
 Law and very Beneficial to the People of this Province Be it there-
 fore enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary by
 and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordships Governor and
 the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly and the Authority of the
 same that the same Act shall be Perpetual and is hereby continued
 to be and remain in full Force for ever
