[Preamble]

Whereas by Virtue of the said Act for erecting a County School in Worcester County and Appointing the Visitors for the same and of another Act entituled an Act for the Encouragement of Learning and erecting Schools in the several Countys within this Province the Visitors of the same County School are Authorized and directed to Purchase one hundred Acres of Land or more for the Use of the said School

And Whereas it is represented to this General Assembly that the funds of the said School are insufficient for Purchasing so large a Quantity of Land that it will be more Commodious and convenient to Purchase in Lieu thereof four lotts of Ground in the Town of Snow Hill for the use of the said School Be it therefore enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lordships Governor and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly and the Authority of the same That the Visitors
