No. 31 An Act for erecting a Publick School in Frederick County

XXXII] Whereas it is reasonable that Education should be extended equally to the several Parts of the Province and that there should be a Publick School erected in ffrederick County as Well as the other Counties

[Preamble]

Be it therefore enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary By and with Advice and Consent of his Lordships Governor and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly and the Authority of the same that in Order to the erecting and Building a House and other Conveniencies for a County School there shall be one Acre of Land Purchased in Frederick Town in ffrederick County by the Persons hereafter named who shall be Visitors of the said School Viz.^t Coll Thomas Cresap M.^r Thomas Beattys M.^r Nathan Magruder Captain Joseph Chapline M.^r John Darnall Colonel Samuel Beall and the Reverend M.^r Thomas Bacon which said Persons so nominated Visitors for ffrederick County School shall Qualify in the same Manner and be Subject to the same Penalties and be invested with the same Right Privileges Powers and Authorities as the Visitors of the other County Schools within this Province and shall have Succession in like Manner
