Gentlemen

The General Question between us is whether the Clerk of the Council for his Services to the public shall be allowed in the Journal the Annual Salary of 9600^{lb} of Tobo payable at the Rate of 12^s:6^d p Cent hitherto always claimed of and paid by the Public in every former Journal regulated and assented by all the Branches of the Legislature Or whether he shall be allowed Nothing in the Journal for his Services to the Public [*The message beginning thus is printed in full in the Upper House journal, pp. 97-110*]
