Ordered that M.<sup>r</sup> J: Goldsborough and M.<sup>r</sup> Dent do Acquaint his  
 Excellency that no Publick Business lays before this House to  
 Transact

Samuel Chamberlayne Esq.<sup>r</sup> and Col.<sup>o</sup> Lloyd from the Upper  
 House Acquaint M.<sup>r</sup> Speaker that the Governor requires the At-  
 tendance of the Members of the Lower House immediately in the  
 Upper House

M.<sup>r</sup> Speaker left the Chair and with the Members of the Lower  
 House went to the upper House and presented to his Excellency An  
 Ingrossed Bill Entituled an Act to continue all such Acts of As-  
 sembly of this Province as would expire with this Session of As-
