In a Plea of trespasse upon th^e case

The said Francis Pope th^e Plaintife made his personall Appearance to prosecute th^e suite Commenced by him as aforesaid ag^t th^e said Walter Beane th^e Defend^t who Likewise made his personall appearance to defend th^e same.

Hereupon the Plaintife Declared upon an Account for severall things had of Arthur Turner in his life time from Richard Smyth w^{ch} was as followeth

M^r Arthur Turner Debtor to th^e Estate of Richard Smyth late dec^d as followeth.

For his Sonnes diet one year.....	550 ^{lb} tob.
It. for one Steare.....	600
It. for two hides.....	100
It. for one quarter of Beefe.....	090
It. for Sixteen gallons of Syder.....	160

Likewise th^e Plaintife further Declared upon a Bill passed by the said Turner to th^e said Pope in his life time for th^e Payment of 1074^{lb} of tobaccoe w^{ch} was as followeth (viz^t)

This Bill bindeth me Arthur Turner my heires Executors and Administrators to pay or cause unto Francis Pope and John Hatch two of th^e Admin^{rs} of th^e estate of Richard Smyth their heires Executors Admin^{rs} or assignes the full and just Summe of one Thousand Seaventie foure pounds of tobaccoe and Caske to be paid at some Convenient place in Charles County at or upon th^e tenth day of November next ensueing th^e Date hereof As Witnes my hand this 2^d Day of Aprill 1664.

Whereupon th^e Defend^t demanded an Allowance of th^e Summe of 550^{lb} of tobaccoe for Caske, and 300^{lb} of tobaccoe for a Suite of Cloathes due from th^e estate of Richard Smith to th^e estate of Arthur Turner and requested th^t both th^e said Summes might be deducted out of th^e Totall Summe of 2574^{lb} of tobaccoe for w^{ch} th^e Plaintife sued which was done accordinglie and th^e Remainder being 1724^{lb} of tobaccoe th^e Defend^t acknowledged a Judgement for th^e same to th^e Plaintife and th^e Court thereupon ordered th^t The Defend^t should Pay and Satisfie th^e said Summe of 1724^{lb} of tobaccoe to th^e Plaintife, but th^e Plaintife to pay costs of suite.

Likewise th^e said m^r Beane acknowledged a Judgment for 9 Barrels and a halfe of Corne at 60^{lb} of tobaccoe p Barrell due to James Bowling from th^e estate of Arthur Turner afores^d dec^d
