And whereupon the said Nicholas Complaineth against th^e said James For that that is to say That Whereas th^e said Nicholas at diverse and Sundrie times and at th^e instance and request of th^e said James Sold and delivered to him th^e said James in Ordinarie accommoda^{cion} th^e soe much as in th^e whole Amounteth to th^e Summe of five hundred sixtie one pounds of tobaccoe an Account whereof th^e said Nicholas is readie to Produce in Court w^{ch} said Totall Summe of 561th of tobaccoe & all and Severall th^e particular Summes in th^e said Account from time to time acruing and Amounting thereunto th^e said James did assume upon himselfe and faithfullie promise That he th^e same to th^e said Nicholas well and truelie would Satisfie and Pay when thereunto Required But yet Notwithstanding he th^e said James not regarding his said promise and Assumption hath refused to Satisfie the said 561th of tobaccoe to th^e said Nicholas and doth still refuse to doe th^e same Whereupon he brings his suite

Hereupon th^e said Nicholas and th^e said James Produced their Severall Accounts in Court and It was ordered th^t Stephen Montague and George Thompson should Audit th^e same and make report thereof to th^e Court w^{ch} accordinglie they did and found That M^r James Lyndsey did stand indebted unto Nicholas Emanson in th^e quantitie of 351th of tobaccoe upon th^e Ballance of all Accounts between them from th^e Beginning of th^e world till this present time

Ordered Therefore th^t th^e said M^r Lyndsey Satisfie and Pay unto th^e said Nicholas th^e said Summe of 351th of toba^c wth Charges and costs of suite.
