And whereupon th^e said Nicholas Complained against th^e said John For th^t th^t is to say That whereas th^e said Nicholas diverse and Sundrie times at th^e instance and request of th^e said John Sold and delivered to th^e said John in ordinarie Accommoda^{co}ns soe much as in th^e whole amounteth to th^e summe of fourteen hundred, and thirtie pounds of tobaccoe an accompt whereof th^e said Nicholas hath readie to be produced in Court w^{ch} said totall sume of fourteen hundred and thirtie pounds of tobaccoe and all and Severall th^e Summes in th^e said Account from time to time acruing and amounting thereunto the said John did Assume upon himselfe and faithfullie promise That he th^e same to th^e said Nicholas well and truelie would satisfie and pay when he should be thereunto required But Notwthstanding th^e said John to th^e said Nicholas th^e said Severall Summes amounting to th^e said 1430^{lb} of tobaccoe though often thereunto required hath not Satisfied or in anie manner for th^e same Contented, and paid But doth alltogether refuse to Satisfie th^e same Whereupon th^e said Nicholas brings his suite

Hereupon th^e Defend^t Acknowledged a Judgment for th^e said Summe of fourteen hundred and thirtie pounds of tobaccoe to th^e Plaintife

Ordered therefore That th^e Defend^t Satisfie and pay unto th^e Plaintife th^e said Summe wth Costs and Charge of suite.

Robert Sampson Plaintife William Thomas Defend^t
