Whereupon th^e Plaintifes Declaracon was read in C^{rt} to th^e effect as followeth (vizt)

Walter Pake Plaintife Miles Chaffe Defend^t

In a plea of Debt

And Whereupon th^e Plaintife Complaineth ag^t th^e Defend^t For th^t th^t is to Say That Whereas th^e said Miles became indebted to th^e said Walter in th^e full and just quantitie of Seaven hundred Ninetie five pounds of tobaccoe for th^e true Payment of w^{ch} th^e [p. 3] s^d Miles gave Bill to th^e said Walter Now soe it is th^t th^e said Miles being a Nonresident person, and having no settled estat or settled Place of abode in anie part of this Province th^e said Walter humbly Craves th^t this Wor^{ple} Court Require th^e said Miles to give him Sufficient Securitie for th^e Payment of th^e said Debt And &c.

Hereupon th^e Defend^{ts} Attorney entered his Plea that Secundum Actionem Nihil adhuc debet, & th^t th^e Defend^t is noe nonresident person because he had agreed for his Accomodacon this yeare within this Countie and hath undertaken Severall Employments whereby to enable him to Pay the aforesaid Debt

The Premises Considered th^e Judgment of th^e Court is th^t th^e Writt of Arrest not Specifieing anie Securitie th^t th^e Defend^t should give, but onlie th^t he should be taken into th^e Custodie of th^e Sherrife upon a Plea of Debt when as yet th^e said Debt was not due, nor Recoverable Therefore th^e Defend^t ought not to be Compelled to give Security for th^e same

Whereupon William Price Attorney of Walter Pake th^e Plaintife Craveth an Appeale to th^e Provinciaall Court w^{ch} is graunted

Ordered Therefore That th^e Plaintife have Libertie to transmit a Coppie of th^e Proceedings of th^e Court in this Cause to th^e Provinciaall Court attested under th^e Clerkes hand.

M^r Joseph Harrison & M^r Stephen Montague Administrat^{rs} of th^e estate of Richard Randall Dec^d Plaintifes came and made their appearance this C^{rt} to Prosecute th^e Suite Comēced by them against Ignatius Causeen Defend^t in a Plea of Trespasse upon th^e Case.

Ignatius Causeen Defend^t Came and made his Personall appearance this Court to Defend th^e Suite Comēced ag^t him by the said Admin^{rs} as afores^d.
