

Liber D of tobaccoe to th^e R^t Hon^{ble} th^e Lord Proprietary thereby to Acquitt and set free th^e said Joane from th^e penalty of Whipping, & upon his said Acknowledgment It was ordered th^t he should pay th^e s^d tobaccoe as aforesaid, & thereupon th^e s^d Joane to goe free from th^e s^d penalty

John Green Serv^t of M^r Benjamin Rozer being presented to th^e Court was adjudged to be fourteen yeares of age

Hugh Phyllips Serv^t of Colonel Gerrard Fowke being presented to th^e Court was adjudged to be one and twenty yeares of age

Ordered th^t Joseph Cooper keep th^e Child of Arthur Turner late deceased called Anne Turner Notwithstanding th^e s^d Child was formerly ordered to M^r William Marshall, and th^t th^e said Joseph be allowed th^e just quantity of one Thousand pounds of tobaccoe in Consideration of his keeping th^e s^d Child untill November Court next ensuing and afterwards if the Court shall not find another to keep th^e said Child th^e said Joseph shall be allowed eight hundred pounds of tobaccoe p^o annum for keeping th^e same

Elizabeth Love Daughter of William Love was borne th^e Last Day of May Anno Dni 1668

The said William Love Entereth th^e Marke of his hogges and Cattell as followeth viz^t, The Right eare Slitt and underkeel^d & th^e Left eare holed and overkeeled

Joseph Cooper Entereth th^e Marke of his hogges and Cattell as followeth (viz^t) Swallow forked on th^e Right eare and two Nicks on th^e Left

Mary Cooper Daughter of th^e said Joseph Cooper Entereth th^e Marke of her hogges and Cattell as followeth (viz^t) Swallow forked on th^e right eare, and two Nicks under th^e Left eare, and one Nick upon th^e uper side of th^e said eare

William Jenkins Entereth th^e Marke of his hogges and Cattell as followeth (viz^t) A Flower of Deluce in each eare
