

Humphrey Jones Acknowledged this following Conveyance of Land unto George Banks at th^e Court held in th^e County of Charles County in th^e Monthe of June 1668

This Indenture Made the Sixth Day of April in th^e yeare of our Lord god one Thousand Sixe hundred Sixty and eight Between Humphrey Jones of Charles County in th^e Province of Maryland on th^e one part and George Bankes of S^t Maries County and th^e province afores^d planter on th^e other part Witnesseth That th^e s^d Humphrey Jones as well for and in Consideration of three thousand pounds of tobaccoe, and caske by two Severall Bills past to th^e s^d Humphrey Jones his heires Executors Admin^{rs} and Assignes by the said George Bankes one Bill for one Thousand pounds of tobaccoe and Caske to be paid Anno one Thousand Sixe hundred Sixty, & eight The other Bill for two Thousand pounds of tobaccoe and Caske Anno to be paid one Thousand Sixe hundred Sixty and Nine before
