John borne of Phillis Hayward is by the Consent of th^e Court & his Mother bound to M^r W^m Barton his heires or Assigns for 21 yeares he or they paying to him at th^e Expiration of th^e time according to th^e Custome of th^e Country to servants

The p^lt complaineth ag^t the Defend^t for th^t the Defend^t standeth indebted unto him by byll under his hand & seale bearing date the 14^o of January 1667 in the Sum^e of one thousand & fifty pounds of Tobacco as by th^e ^sd byll may appeare & being there unto required hath refused & as yet doth refuse th^e ^sd sum^e of Tobacco to th^e p^lt^s Damage of one thousand five hundred pounds where upon he bringeth his suite and craveth order ag^t the Defend^t for th^e ^sd sum^e of Tobacco with Cost of Suite &c.

Where upon the Defendant pleading th^t it was not demanded th^e P^lt enter'd his answer th^t an Arrest is a sufficient Demand in law upon w^{ch} it is order'd th^t th^e Defendant shall pay the debt & th^e charge to be divided betweene them

Thomas Hussy upon his Lop^s Answer to his peti^con p^rsents a peti^con to th^e Court for to take his evidence th^t he was sick w^{ch} hindred his Coming

Thomas Buckridge aged 26 yeares or there abouts Sworne & examined in open Court saith That on th^e ninth of 9^{br} Tho: Hussey was Distempered wth th^e wind Collick & on th^e 10^o day he had a feaver w^{ch} to out ward appearance hinder'd his Coming
