This Indenture made the eight day of June in th^e yeare of our Lord one thousand six hundred sixty & nine betwixt W^m Allen & John Munn of Charles County in the Province of Mary Land on th^e one parte & Thomas Bennett of S^t Marys County in the afore-said Province of the other parte Witnesseth th^t the s^d W^m Allen & John Munn as well for & in Considera^on of nine thousand pounds of Tobacco & Cask to them in hand p^d by th^e s^d Thom: Bennett where wth th^e s^d W^m Allen & Jo: Munn doe acknowledge themselves fully satisfied & thereof & there from & of & from every part & parcell thereof doe acquit release & discharge the s^d Thomas Bennett his heires Executors & Administrators by these p^rsents As also for diverse other Good Causes & Considerations them there unto moving Have given granted Alien'd bargained Sold enfeoffed & Confirmed And by these p^rsents doe fully Clearly & absolutely give grant alien bargain sell enfeoffe confirme unto the s^d Thom: Bennett his Executors heirs Administrat^{rs} & Assignes for ever all th^t parcell or tract of Land lyeing on th^e north side of Potomucke River in th^e County afore^sd begiⁿing at a marked Locust standing on th^e high Cliffes some two leagus above Caedar point from thence r^uing North by th^e river side for lenght 120 pearchs to a marked white Oake
