Alexander Simpson aged about forty years deposeth, th^t att th^e request of M^r Job Chandler he being then a liver in M^r Job Chandlers house, went along wth th^e Surveyor Gen^r M^r Robert Clarke to marke th^e Division of a parcell of land, depending betwix M^r Job Chandler & M^r Oversee which land they bought of M^r W^m Lewis and Containes two thousand Acres more or less & lies upon th^e East side of Portobacco Creek The Division of w^{ch} land begins att a white Oake standing upon th^e second branch from th^e now dwelling house of M^{rs} Ann Fouke, And further this Deponant saith th^t he hath severall times heard M^r Job Chandler & M^r Simon Oversee speaking & discoursing of th^e Division of th^e said land depending betwixt them And as to th^e same they were both well satisfied, And further saith not.

This Indenture made th^e second day of Aug^t 1669 betwixt Tho: Bennet of S^t Marys County in th^e Province of Maryland of th^e one p^{te} & Tho: Wardner of th^e afore^{sd} County & Province on th^e oth^r p^{te} Witnesseth th^t th^e ^{sd} Tho: Bennet as well for & in Considera^on of 10000^{lb} of Tobacco in Cask to him in hand p^d by th^e ^{sd} Tho: Wardner where wth th^e ^{sd} Bennett doth acknowledge himself to be fully satisfied & th^rof & th^rfrom & of & from every p^{te} & p^{cell} th^rof doe acquit release & discharge th^e ^{sd} Wardner his heirs Execu^{tr}s & Admis^{tr}s by these p^rsents as alsoe for diverse oth^r Good Causes & Considera^ons him unto moveing Have given grant'd aliened bargained sold enfeoffed & Confirmed & by these p^rsents doe fully clearly & absolutly give grant aliene enfeoffe bargaine sell & Con firme unto th^e ^{sd} Wardner his heirs Execu^{tr}s Admis^{tr}s & Assg^s for ever all th^t p^{cell} of Land lying on th^e north side of Potomack river
