[p. 103] Whereupon th^e s^d Richard Complaineth ag^t th^e s^d Nicholas for th^t th^t is to say th^t th^e s^d Nicholas on th^e 13th or 14th of Feb^r last past, & att oth^r times did att his now dwelling house being a house of publick resort & entertainem^t openly falsely & maliciously speake & unter diverse opprobious vilifying disgracefull & Calumniating words tending very much to th^e slandering & Defameing of th^e s^d Rich^d in th^e ꝑ^{sence} & hearing of Diverse persons but more especially Certaine of his Neighbours among whome for any man to live in Credit & Good repute th^e s^d Rich^d humbly supposeth th^e benefite & advantage thereof & th^e Dam^{age} Inconvenience disco^modity & detrim^t That may ensue on th^e Contrary is altogether inexpressible, W^{sh} words afore^sd were in manner as followeth (viz) That th^e s^d Rich^d being indebted to him th^e s^d Nichol: in th^e quantity of seaventeen hundred pounds of tobaccoe on th^e ballance of all Acc^{ts} as th^e s^d Nicho: doth pretend & th^e s^d Rich: refused to pay or to come to Acc^t wth th^e s^d Nicho: or to make him paym^t or satisfaction of th^e same though often thereunto required & th^t he th^e s^d Nicho:
