This Indenture made the eight day of June in th^e yeare of our Lord 1669 Betwixt I Williā Allen of Charles County planter of th^e one parte & Henry Moore of th^e fore^sd County planter of th^e other parte witnesseth th^t th^e s^d Allen for & in Considera^on of a Certaine sume of to^b to him in hand p^d whereof & wherewth he acknowledgeth himself fully satisfied & p^d & of every part & parcell thereof, Hath given granted bargained sold enffeffed and Confirmed & by these p^rs^{nts} doth give grant aliene bargain sell & confirme unto Henry Moore all th^t parcell of land Called maysmoore lying in th^e County afore^sd beginning att a marked Locust tree being th^e Eastermost bound tree of Daniell Mathenias Land standing by Mattawomans Creek from thence runing up th^e Creek & bounding on The s^d Creek wth an Easte & by north line for 100 perches to a marked white Oake standing in a point in an Indian feild by th^e s^d Creek being th^e bound tree of Geo: How's land from thence ruⁿing south & by East for 320 perches to a marked Hickory standing by a Valey from thence runing West & by south for 100 perches till it intersect th^e S by E: line of Daniell Mathena & soe along th^t line to th^e first bound tree Containeing & now laid out for 200 Acres more or less together wth all houses Edifices buildings barnes stables Gardens [p. 112]
