Henry Moore Def^t came alsoe & appeared to defend th^e suite comēced ag^t him by Daniell Johnson whereupon th^e pl^{ts} Declaracon was reade vizt

The s^d Daniell complaineth Ag^t th^e s^d Henry for th^t whereas the said Henry by a certaine writing Obligatory under his hand & Seale beareing Date th^e 17^o Day of July in th^e xxxviii yeare of th^e Dominion of Caecilius Ann^o Domi 1669 did become bound unto him th^e s^d Daniell th^e sume of five hundred eighty six pounds of to^b in portobacco Creeke on or before th^e 10^o of Octo^r in th^e same yeare as by th^e s^d writing here in Court by th^e s^d Daniell produced more att large may appeare nevertheless th^e s^d Henry his s^d obligacōn little regarding but deviscing & fraudulently intending him th^e s^d Daniell of th^e s^d sume of 586^{lb} of to^b to deceive th^e s^d sume of 586^{lb} of to^b to th^e s^d Daniell hath not satisfied according to his obligacōn in th^t behalfe passed but doth altogether refuse to pay th^e same whereupon th^e s^d Daniell saith he hath loss to th^e valew of 800 lb of to^b & thereupon he bringeth his Suite

[p. 129] Whereupon th^e pl^t produced th^e s^d Henry Moores bill w^{ch} th^e s^d Moore could not deny to be his Act & Deed It was therefore ordered th^t th^e s^d Henry Moore Def^t pay unto Daniell Johnson Pl^t th^e s^d sume of five hundred eighty six pounds of to^b wth Costs & Charges of suite or else Execution.

Sam^{ll} Fendall Def^t came also & appeared to defend th^e suite comēced ag^t him by Daniell Johnson Whereupon th^e pl^{ts} Declaracon was reade

The s^d Daniell Complaineth ag^t th^e s^d Sam^{ll} for th^t whereas th^e s^d Sam^{ll} by two certaine writings under his hand bearcing Date th^e tenth Day of February 1668 did become bound unto him th^e s^d Daniell to d^{ed} unto him th^e s^d Daniell one warr^t for one hundred Acres of Land in his owne name by th^e last of Aprill in th^e same yeare & to pay unto th^e s^d Daniell th^e sume of three hundred & tenn pounds of tobacco never the less th^e s^d Sam^{ll} his said obligation little regarding but minding & fraudulently intending him th^e s^d Daniell of th^e s^d Warrant for one hundred Acres of Land & th^e s^d sume of three hundred & tenn pounds of to^b to deceive th^e s^d warr^t for 100 Acres of Land hath not delivered nor th^e s^d sume of 310^{lb} of to^b to th^e s^d Daniell hath not yet p^d According to his obligacōn pass^d as afore^sd but doth altogether refuse to pay or satisfy th^e same whereupon th^e s^d Daniell saith he is damnified & hath Loss to th^e Valew of 900^{lb} of to^b whereupon he bringeth his suite
