And whereupon th^e s^d Rich^d complaineth ag^t th^e s^d James for th^t wheras th^e s^d James in th^e month of Apr^r in th^e xxxvii yeare of Caecilus 1668 & att severall daies & tim^s since had & rec^d from th^e s^d Rich^d divers goods & Accomodacons & Attendance am^eing to 660th of to^b in Considera^on whereof th^e s^d Jam^s did Assume upon himself & to th^e s^d Rich^d did p^mise th^t he th^e s^d James th^e s^d su^me of 660th of to^b to him th^e s^d Rich^d wⁿ thereunto required would well & truly satisfy & pay Never th^e less th^e s^d James his s^d promise & Assump^on little regarding but deviseing & fraudulenty intending him th^e s^d Rich^d of th^e s^d su^me of 660th to deceive th^e s^d su^me of 660th of to^b hath not p^d according to his promise to th^e s^d Rich^d on th^t behalfe made but doth altogether refuse to pay th^e same to his th^e s^d Rich^{ds} great Damage whereupon he saith he is damnified to th^e Valew of 900th of to^b & hereupon he bringeth his suite.

Whereupon th^e Def^t replied th^t he had noe Attendance att th^e pl^{ts} house & hereupon th^e pl^t requested th^t Edw^d Maddock might have his oath given him who was sworne

Edw^d Maddock aged 22 or 23 years sworne & saith th^t to his knowledge th^e Def^t was very dangerously att th^e pl^{ts} house a fourte-night or three weeks & th^t th^e pl^t had a great deale of trouble wth th^e Def^t dureing th^t time

Jn^o Kimbrow aged 29 years or therabouts sworne & saith th^t one day wⁿ he was going to work att Rob^t Clearks he called att M^r Lomax his house where he se James Hayes & he s^d James yo^u are very ill & he answered I wish th^t Goody Dodd or some would come to him & I answered I would Indeavoure to get her to come & wthin two or three daies he came to Rich^d Dodds him self but further saith not

whereupon th^e pl^t & Mary his Wife p^duced an Acc^t w^{ch} th^e Def^t denied but never th^e less he told th^e Court if th^e Pl^t & his Wife would sweare to th^e ensueing Acc^t he would pay them th^e Acc^t whereupon they were sworne & say th^t it is a true acc^t & th^t they never rec^d any satisfacoⁿ
