And whereupon th^e said John & Robert Complaineth against th^e said Henry For that whereas th^e said Henry oweth th^e 27 day of Octo^r in th^e yeare of our Lord 1669 or thereabouts had & rec^d from th^e said Francis Bullock severall goods & Marchantdizes am^{ing} to th^e Valew of three hundred fifty nine pounds of tobaccoe as by a particular Acc^t here in Court by th^e said John Hatch & Robert Rowland produced att large may appeare in Considera^on whereof th^e s^d Henry did then Assume upon himself & to th^e s^d Francis did faithfully promise th^t he th^e said Henry th^e s^d sume of 359th of to^b w^a thereunto required to th^e s^d Francis would well & truly satisfy & pay yet never th^e less th^e s^d Henry his s^d promise & Assump^on little regarding th^e s^d sume of 359th of to^b hath not p^d neither to th^e said Francis dureing his life time nor to th^e s^d John & Robert since his Death but doth altogether refuse to pay th^e same whereby th^e s^d John & Robert have Loss to Valew of five hundred p^ds of to^b & thereupon they bring their suite [p. 162]

Edm^d Taylor of Charls County planter Complaineth ag^t Arch: Wahab of th^e same planter & Jane his Wife in an Ac^c of trespass upon th^e Case for th^t (viz) whereas Alexander Simpson lately deceased stood indebted to th^e pl^t four hundred pounds of to^b in Leiu^e of his full share of th^e Crop made att th^e Said Simpsons house th^e last yeare which said sume th^e said Alexander never p^d in his life time nor th^e s^d Jane since th^e dec^s of th^e said Alexander although often thereunto requested & therefore hee pray Judgem^t

And whereupon Rich^d Boughton Attur for th^e Def^{ts} in barrs of th^e Declara^on of th^e Pl^{ts} saith th^t for th^t neither th^e Def^t nor his Wife are mentioned to be Adm^{trs} Adm^{trix} in th^e Pl^{ts} Declara^on which as he Conceivs they ought to be therefore he humbly craves a Non-suite which was denied him [p. 164]
