

- This Indenture made th^e first day of July in nine & thirtieth yeare
 [p. 9] of th^e Dominion of Caecilius Absolute Lord And Proprietary of th^e Province of Maryland & Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore Ann^d Domini one thousand six hundred & seaventy Betweene Stephen Mountague of Charls County in th^e Province of Maryland Planter of th^e one part And Hugh French of th^e County & Province aforešd Planter of th^e other parte Witnesseth th^t th^e šd Stephen Mountague as well for & in Consideracōn of the Quantity of tenn thousand poundes of Tobacco to him in hand paid by th^e šd Hugh French th^e receipt whereof th^e šd Stephen Mountague doth hereby acknowledge
 [p. 10] & of Every parte & parcell thereof doth hereby absolutely & clearly exonerate acquitt & discharge th^e šd Hugh French his Executors Administrato^{rs} & Assignes by these p^rsnts Give grant bargaine aliene sell enfeoffe and Confirme unto him th^e šd Hugh French his heirs & Assignes forever all th^t parcell of land Called by th^e name of Batchellours harbour lyeing on th^e East side of PisCataway river about two miles from Piscataway Creek beginning at a marked
 [p. 11] Cedar standing att th^e mouth of a Creek in th^e šd river Called S^t Georgio Creeke & running south and East downe th^e river for th^e length of three hundred & twenty perchs to A marked red Oake standing att th^e mouth of a Creeke Called Jecomo Creeke bounding on south wth th^e šd Creeke & a line drawn East north East for th^e length of five hundred perches to a marked Oake on th^e East wth a line drawne North West from th^e end of th^e former line to th^e head of a Creeke th^t falleth into S^t Georgio's Creeke call'd Ash Creeke on th^e north wth th^e said Creeke on th^e West wth th^e šd river
