This Indenture made the second day of January one thousand Six Liber E hundred and seventy Betweene George Langham of Charles County & Province of Maryland planter of the one part and Thomas Maris of the same County planter of the other part witnesseth / the sd George Langham as well for & in consideracon of the quantety of three thousand three hundred poundes of tob and caske in hand payd before ensealeing and delivery hereof by the s^d Thomas Maris whereof and wherewth the sd George Langham doth acknowledge himselfe to be fully satisfied contented and payd & thereof and of every part and parcell thereof doth acquitt and discharge the sd Thomas Maris his heyres Execut^{rs} & Administ^{rs} and every of th^m by these p^rsents as allso for divers other good causes and consideracons him hereunto moveing have granted bargained sold assigned set over and [fol. 8] confirmed and by these preents doe fully clearely and absolutely grant bargaine sell assigne sett over and confirm unto the sd Thomas Maris his heyres Execut^{rs} Administrat^{rs} and Assignes all th^t parcell of land Scituat lyeing and being in Charles County aforesd Lyeing in the woodes begining at a bounded birch tree standing on the East side of a fresh runn being the bound tree of Capt Wiff Stone Mannor called Poynton, runing thence west north west, bindeing on the land formerly layd out for Mr James Lindsy for length three hundred and twenty pches, to a bounded red oake thence west south west one hundred and fifety pches to a bound tree Joyneing upon the land of Capt William Stone binding upon the manner untill it comes to the first bound tree containing by estimacon one hundred acres be the same more or lesse now in the Tennor or occupacon of George Langham or his Assignes being a parcell of land purchased of Gerrard Browne and taken up by him the sd Gerrard Browne called Drury lane will appeare by certificate entered in the office beareing date the tenth of March last past All and Singuler wch sd parcell of land together wth all and singuler the houses buildings or Edifices wtsoever thereunto belonging or appurtaineing together wth all the Orchards Gardens pastures feedings Comons commons of pastures Range for Hoggs woods under woodes water watercourses fishing fowleing easm^{ts} profitts comodetyes and hereditam^{ts} w^tsoever unto the sd parcell of Land belongeing or appertaineing, To Have & to Hold the sd parcell of Land and all and singuler the prmisses aforemenconed to be hereby bargained and sold wth the appurtenances and every part and parcell thereof wtsoever before named or recited unto the sd Thomas Maris his heyres Executrs Administratrs & Assignes for ever veilding and payeing yearly the Lord Propryetaryes Rent for the s^d parcell of land in manner and form as shall be in the Pattent expressed, and the sd George Langham for himselfe his heyres Execut^{rs} & Administrat^{rs} doth covenant grant and agree to and wth the sd Thomas Maris his heyres Executrs Administratrs & Assignes and every of thm by these preents tht he the sd Thomas Maris his heyres Execut^{rs} Administrat^{rs} and Assignes shall and may lawfully [fol. 9]
