The Humble petition of Elizabeth Munkister Relict of John Charman late of this County decd Humbly Sheweth

That whereas at a Court held in Charles County the tenth day of August in the year of our Lord 1668, In a Certain matter of difference depending between John Charman pft & Robert Downes Def^t in a plea of trespasse it was then ordered that a warr^t should be Issued to the Sheriff by a Jury of twelve men to Enquire whose land the Same was, of w^{ch} warrant returne being made by the Sheriff & the Said Robert Downes by the Same found to be guilty of the Said Trespas & time given to the Said John Charman till the Ensueing Court

After that order the Said John Charman happening before the Said Court to an untimely End yo^r peticoner having by yo^r worships Consents taken time to psent her bill of Costs here under written Humbly Craves yo^r worships would be pleased to allow the Same there being no more but what can Justly be made appeare & yo^r peticoner as in duty Bound Shall Ever pray &c.
